**CITY OF CAVE SPRING WATER USAGE GUIDELINES
LEVEL IVb APPROVED 8/25/08**

The City of Cave Spring Water Department has been approved for the Level IVb Drought Response Modification. Guidelines set forth by Georgia Department of Natural Resources are shown below:

- All outdoor water uses are allowed on an odd/even basis, two days per week between midnight and 10:00 a.m. Odd-numbered addresses may water on Tuesdays and Thursdays; even-numbered addresses may water on Mondays and Wednesdays.
- Odd-numbered addresses may water by hand on Sunday for a total of 25 minutes using a garden hose within the hours of midnight and 10:00 a.m. Even-numbered addresses may water by hand on Saturday in the same manner.
- Newly installed landscaping that has been in place less than 30 days may be watered up to three days a week within the hours of midnight to 10:00 a.m. only for 10 consecutive weeks and during plant installation. Odd-numbered addresses may water newly installed landscaping Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Sundays. Even-numbered addresses may water newly installed landscaping Mondays, Wednesdays, and Saturdays. Any person watering newly installed landscaping must register with the Outdoor Water Use Registration Program at <http://www.urbanagcouncil.com>.
- Filling of swimming pools, without restrictions on day or time, is allowed.
- Washing hard surfaces, such as streets, gutters, sidewalks, and driveways is prohibited except when necessary for public health and safety.

The City will continue to monitor overall water usage. The above guidelines may change based on continuing drought conditions and the mandated reduction of water use. Therefore, please be diligent in observing the guidelines currently in place.
